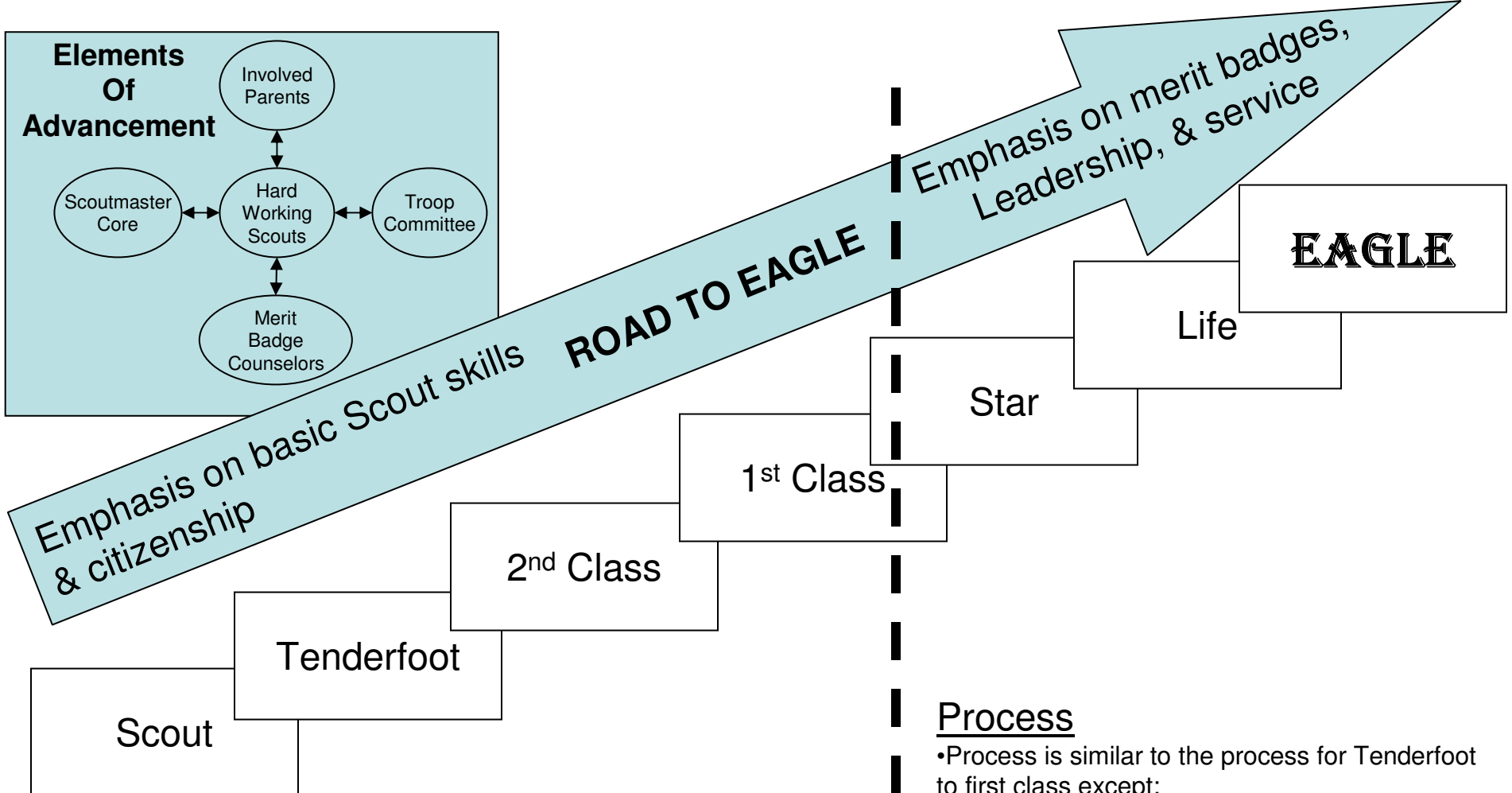
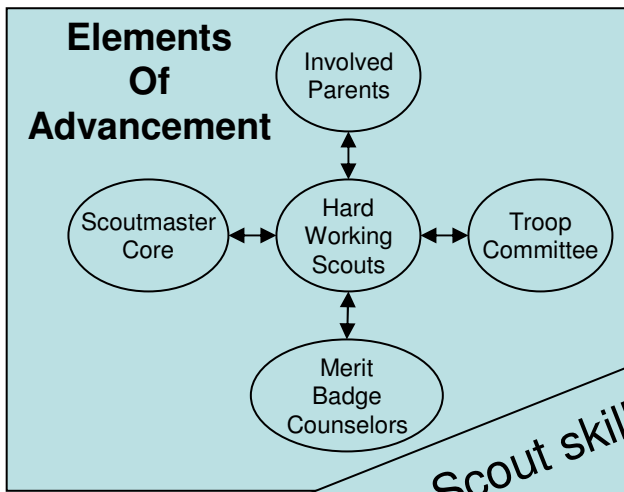


Scout Learns – Scout is Tested – Scout is Reviewed – Scout is Recognized



Process

- Scouts work on requirements at home, during troop meetings, and on campouts.
- Scout demonstrates that he has met the requirement to a Scoutmaster, SPL, ASPL, or Troop Guide who initials the Scout's handbook
- After all requirements are complete for a rank, the Scout participates in a Scoutmaster Conference
- Scout participates a Board of Review with the Troop Committee. New rank is approved if the Scout passes the Board of Review.

Process

- Process is similar to the process for Tenderfoot to first class except:
 - More work is done outside troop meetings
 - Scouts must work with merit badge counselors and show them they have completed requirements for a merit badge.
 - The Eagle rank requires a special project, special Board of Review, additional paperwork, and review of documented progress.
